

SESSION TIPS FOR *Pet Sessions*

- 1) We don't want to believe it, but our animals think we're nuts for this. It's OK. I'm not judging you, since I've been subjecting my dogs to this experience for AGES.
- 2) Just like people, our four-legged friends should be reasonably well groomed, or at least bathed. Pay special attention to their cleaning eyes and the mustache area, since those will be prominently featured.
- 3) Keep in mind that **we generally shoot face forward**, so if you choose an outfit for them with a logo or other writing on it, we probably won't see it.
- 4) If your furry kids need to be on a leash, buy something cute even if you don't get them an adorable outfit. **You don't want a beat up old collar and half-chewed leash in your forever photos!**
- 5) Remember to bring their favorite toys, noise makers, and high reward treats.
- 6) If we are shooting outside, **consider arriving a little early to let your pet investigate the area and become familiar with it.** Animals are a curious lot, and we don't want them getting distracted during the shoot.
